



DON'T FALL INTO THE WARRANTY TRAP!

Here's what Other Companies make you do to transfer their warranty:

1. You or your client call the foundation company to request the warranty transfer paperwork.
2. You wait for the paperwork to arrive.
3. You gather all the requested information from the buyers and sellers to fill in the paperwork.
4. You complete the forms and send it back in **IN THE TIME ALLOTTED**.
5. You call the foundation repair company to see if the paperwork has been received and get confirmation of transfer.
6. Often, your client must pay a transfer fee (typically around \$100 or more) to transfer the warranty to the buyer.
7. If all of these conditions are not met within the time allotted by the foundation repair company (typically within 30 days of date of sale), the warranty is void and cannot be re-instated.

Here's how the ASSUMABLE WARRANTY from Williamson works:

1. You don't have to do a thing! Our warranty stays with the home and is automatically assumed by any and all subsequent owners. No forms... no fees... no kidding!
